

# 70000 Britannia set to steam to Windsor for Queen's Jubilee next year

'The Royal Charter' will embark on its journey from Crewe to Windsor on the Jubilee bank holiday, Friday 3rd June. The luxury Saphos carriages will be hauled by '70000 Britannia', which was built at Crewe Works in 1951. The special train will also pick up passengers at Stafford and Nuneaton.

On arrival at Windsor, there will be plenty of time for guests to stretch their legs, explore the wide range of cafes and bars, or take the short walk to the largest and oldest occupied castle in the world!
