

Applications for £50k Transform community fund now open

The latest Transform Grants Fund is now live with more than £50,000 of funding for community and environmental projects available.

As part of the scheme, which has been launched by train company TransPennine Express (TPE), organisations and individuals from across the North and Scotland are being invited to apply for grants of up to £5k to help support causes across the rail network.

Applicants will have until 17:00 on 7 February 2021 to submit their entries which should be submitted via the TPE website: tpexpress.co.uk/about-us/community/transform-grants

Last year, the train company donated £50k to 12 recipients as part of the annual competition supporting initiatives including an outdoor adventure programme at Southgate School in West Yorkshire, a book quest project by the National Literacy Trust and a new learning centre for the Whirlow Hall Farm Trust in Lincolnshire.
