In an exciting move to support Anglo-German supply and innovation, the BCRRE Rail Alliance is hosting a trade mission with German companies later this month. The German Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy, the BMWi, is coming to the UK and there are two dates to meet the delegates from the German rail industry, on Tuesday 23 November in London and on Thursday 25 November in Birmingham.

Both events are free to attend and registration is welcome from all sectors of our industry. Attendees will hear about the products and services the German companies are looking for currently, and about opportunities to come together to work on new solutions, products and ideas. This inward mission is supporting UK companies to become part of a supply chain that delivers not only in the UK but with our trade partners across Europe.

The visiting delegation represents a significant portion of the German rail industry which, itself, was worth over €12.5bn in 2020. Sectors represented include manufacturers of vehicles, components, HVAC and vibration control; fire and safety products; infrastructure safety products; and communication and passenger information systems. Each company has identified innovation and supply needs which they wish to discuss with British suppliers and collaborators so there are plenty of opportunities for the UK supply



chain!
