

D2 Rail appoints Head of Programme Management to accelerate growth

He added: "By 2023 it is my aspiration that D2 will be able to provide the Programme/Project Management Office capability to clients to manage all aspects of the design, build and hand-back of complex multidisciplinary programmes and projects.

"To achieve the above I aim to continue to build direct in-house capability as well as partnering with other organisations in either a support or lead role.



"Now that the worst of the pandemic is behind us there is a huge need to invest in the economy. With the devolution of budgets down to regional areas in all types of sectors there is the absolute need for programmes and projects to be delivered efficiently.

"D2 now has this capability and I am really excited to be able to offer this service to both client-based organisations as well as the wider supply chain."
