


Digital Catapult welcomes nine innovators onto pioneering accelerator spearheading Al adoption in transport

The FutureScope High Growth AI Accelerator for BridgeAI is designed to empower participants in crafting AI and ML solutions that are not just technologically advanced but also grounded in responsible innovation and ethics. The 9 startups joining the FutureScope High Growth AI Accelerator for BridgeAI are:
