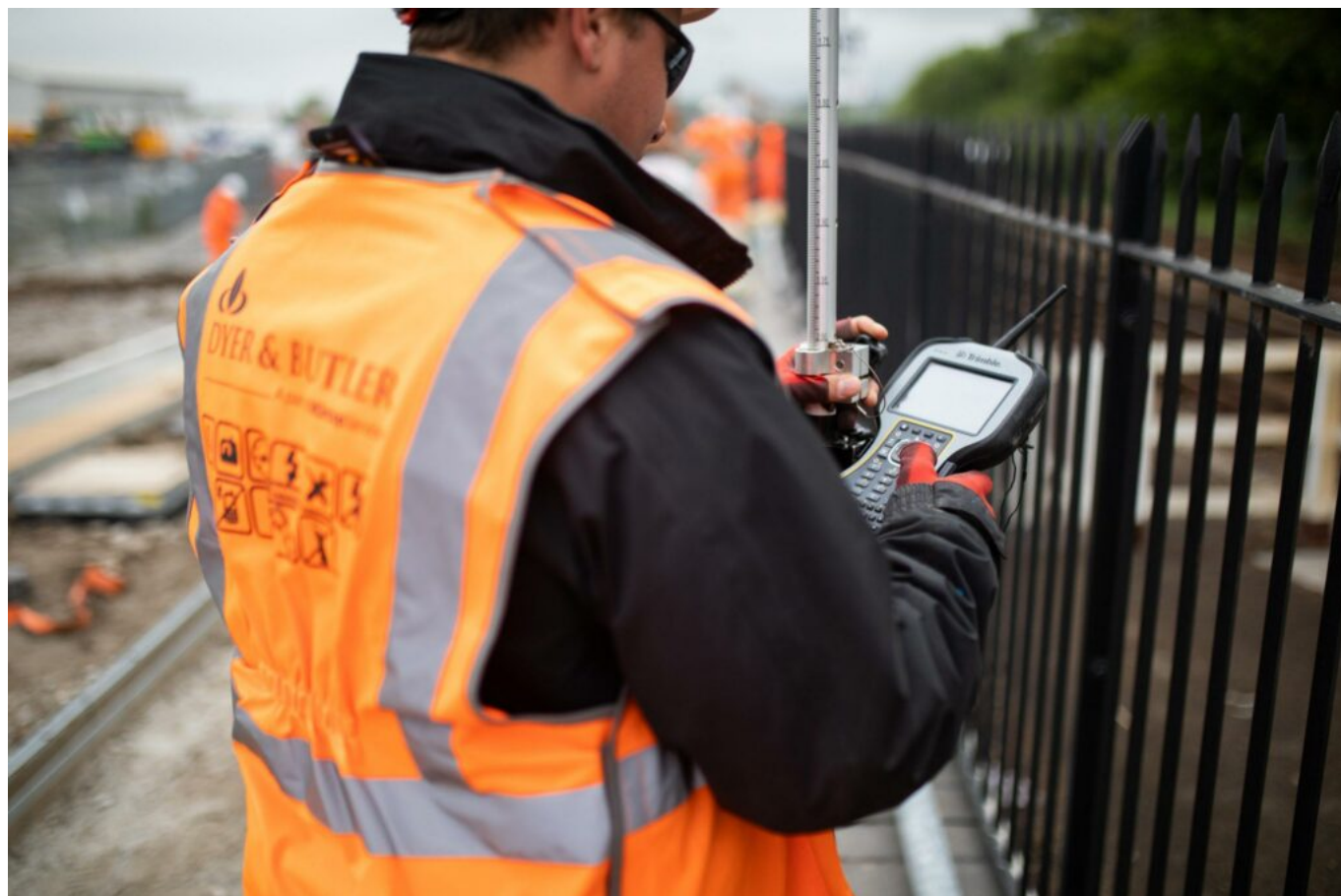


Dyer & Butler Rail Division Recognised for Health & Safety Excellence with RoSPA Gold Medal Award
