

DB Cargo UK appoints new COO

DB Cargo UK has a new chief operating officer.

Neil Ethell, formerly the company's Head of Operations and Service Delivery, has taken over the role with immediate effect.

Neil has more than two decades of experience in logistics, having joined the company in 2002. Since then, he has held a number of senior roles at DB, developing an in-depth knowledge of rail freight operations, service delivery, asset and resource management.

He said: "I am relishing the challenge of joining the UK Board at a time when the industry continues to face some significant operational challenges as we emerge from the pandemic and postBrexit transition period.

Neil's appointment is the latest in a series of UK Board changes made by the company's new CEO Andrea Rossi; earlier this year Andrea announced a new strategy to achieve the company's vision of becoming the

Andrea said: "Neil's promotion comes after a rigorous selection process and I am looking forward to working with him and the rest of the UK Board to further improve the overall customer experience provided by DB.

"To coincide with Neil's appointment, we are also taking the opportunity to make a number of internal, organisational changes to strengthen links between our sales and service design functions which I'm confident will make us much more agile and responsive to our customers' needs."

As a result of these changes, head of sales Roger Neary will now become chief sales officer, a title which DB says more accurately reflects his position within the company and wider industry.
