


Linxon expands its local presence in UK

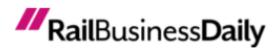
In addition to opening an office in Stoke-on-Trent in late 2020, Linxon has announced it is now establishing its new Birmingham office in the Snow Hill area.
