

Merseyrail going back to 15-minute services

From Monday 2 May, Merseyrail has said it will start to operate a 15-minute service across most of its network.

This means a return to its pre-COVID frequency, the operator said.

The changes are as follows:

- **Southport line** – every 15 minutes from the start to the end of service
- **All other lines (except Ellesmere Port)** – every 15 minutes between approximately 07:00 and 19:00, with a 30-minute service operating outside of these hours
- **Ellesmere Port line** – every 30 minutes from the start to the end of service every day with additional trains running between 07:15 and 08:30 for the morning peak and 16:30 and 17:30 for the evening peak Monday to Friday

A 30-minute service will operate on Sundays across all lines.
