


Network Rail among best places to work in Glassdoor's Employees' Choice Awards

Network Rail has been ranked 29th in the top 50 best places to work in the UK by Glassdoor, one of the world's largest job and recruiting sites, as part of its *Employees' Choice Awards*.

Winners of the awards are determined solely by employee feedback shared anonymously on the Glassdoor's website over the past year. Network Rail employees using the jobs website have cited a supportive work culture, family atmosphere, flexible working policies, competitive pay and benefits, and opportunities for progression as reasons for scoring their employer highly.

This is Network Rail's first appearance in the top 50 list, having achieved an overall company rating of 4.2 out of five – recognition of its efforts to become a better employer for its 41,000-strong workforce.

Pauline Holroyd, group HR director at Network Rail, said: "I'm really pleased that Network Rail is among Glassdoor's Best Places to Work for 2021.
