

Network Rail picks next Group Property Director

Network Rail has appointed Robin Dobson as group property director, replacing Stuart Kirkwood who is leaving the organisation after 11 years' service, the last two of which were spent leading Network Rail's property division.

Robin joins Network Rail from Hammerson Plc – a property development and investment company – bringing experience in all property asset classes from across the UK and Europe.

Robin joins Network Rail on 21 March, when he and Stuart will begin a handover process to ensure a smooth transition before Stuart leaves Network Rail on 31 March.

Robin said: "I am excited to be joining Network Rail at this time. The focus will be on infrastructure growth and delivering developments across Great Britain with both the private sector and public partnerships, particularly in support of the Government's levelling-up agenda around housing and investment."

expertise will be of real value as the industry plays its role in supporting Britain's recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic.
