

Nexus open for apprenticeships

Nexus has announced that there are nine apprenticeships up for grabs across the Nexus organisation – and the application process is now up open at www.nexus.org.uk/apprenticeships

Roles include project management, human resources, data science, bus services, and infrastructure maintenance on the Tyne and Wear Metro, including overhead line and structures.

The closing date for applicants is Sunday 26 February.

Nexus has a successful track record in recruiting apprentices, with most progressing on to permanent full-time employment or higher-level training after serving their time as trainees.

Head of learning at Nexus, Heather Blevins, said: “We’re looking forward to welcoming a diverse mix of talented people who are keen to start careers in the transport industry in 2023. Apprenticeships are vital for the long-term future of Nexus.
