Northern training the next generation of railway professionals

In the last six years, more than 2,500 colleagues have graduated from its trainee and apprenticeships schools with 1,500 conductors and nearly 1,100 train drivers entering service.

Training academies in Manchester and Leeds host all Northern's new trainees but have also supported the learning development of train drivers from Great Western and drivers and conductors at Grand Central.
