

Rail Innovation Exhibition Returns

The rail sector's latest developments will be on display when the [Rail Innovation Exhibition](#) opens its doors on 18 October at the National Conference Centre, Birmingham.

More than 500 delegates from the rail industry, research groups, academia, and Government, will attend the Rail Innovation Exhibition 2023 later this month.

The exhibition, delivered by the UK's innovation agency, Innovate UK, aims to showcase the projects funded by the Department for Transport and includes talks from industry leaders, Network Rail and DfT. Exhibitors, including Siemens, Network Rail, RIA, RSSB, Zugbox, Meteor Power Ltd, Varamis, and Hydroflex, will fill the show floor with cutting edge technology and new solutions at various stages of the R&D commercialisation process.
