After a two-year hiatus, the annual Transport Benevolent Fund Rail Staff Carol Service has returned.

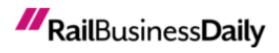
Rail Minister, Huw Merriman MP, will join colleagues from across the railway as we celebrate the season with readings, and carols led by London's Transport Choir.
