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SSE Enterprise Rail has been awarded a prestigious Beacon Award by London Underground (LUL) for work carried out on its network.

SSE Enterprise Rail achieved Beacon status for its work on LUL's Ruislip Depot Signal Equipment Room (SER) site.

LUL recognises suppliers who demonstrate good practice in site management through the Beacon scheme, contributing to an excellent safety record on London Underground projects and ensuring that all work at project sites and maintenance depots is undertaken safely and considerately.

The awards recognise suppliers who demonstrate outstanding performance in health and safety and are presented to companies who meet strict criteria on health and safety standards; leadership and



management; environmental issues and consideration for those affected by works.
