As we launch COMET Assured in January 2022, it is expected to assist the project in prioritising & addressing systemic root causes, and maintaining performance improvement throughout the construction."

The problem-solving company has also entered a six-figure contract earlier this month with East West Rail following a successful related project to create an engaging product to further develop the company's equality, diversity, and inclusion programme. The product will allow East West Rail to deploy innovative approaches to detecting problems and opportunities from different angles, developing competency in inclusive behaviours to ensure the right people are involved in the right situations, and that everyone's input is valued.

Mark Rushton, Managing Director at STC INSISO added: "Our solutions and behavioural competency programmes are about being aware of unconscious bias, based upon an individual's values, technical experience, and background.
