Adriaan Bekker, director of Sustainability Sciences, which is behind the programme, said: "The central government's social value model and procurement policy have created a sense of urgency to prioritise sustainability and social value issues in service disciplines and project delivery as it measurably impacts working winning ability.

"This has resulted in a need to plan, gather evidence, and measure performance continuously and in the long term."





Some specific examples of this policy's impact are:

- The Procurement Policy Note 06/20 mandates a minimum overall weighting of 10 per cent for central government procurement.
- The Procurement Policy Note 06/21 requires compliant Carbon Reduction Plans that have been made publicly available.

Adriaan said: "Sustainable procurement policies from industry and government is rippling through supply chains, as they directly impact tier 1 suppliers who subsequently need supply chain support and collaboration for success.

"However, SMEs and tier 2 and 3 suppliers face greater challenges due to resource constraints and the need for long-term planning and expert support for successful procurement events."
