The new organisational structure includes a number of senior promotions.

- Jason Worrall has been appointed to MD Engineering Services and will be responsible for Taziker’s Engineering Solutions, Industrial Services and Access divisions. Jason has also taken on the role of CEO for Taziker’s existing contract scaffolding business, Network Scaffolding Contractors Ltd.
- Neil Harrison has been appointed MD Infrastructure where he will have responsibility for all regional operations as well as a newly formed ‘On-Site Engineering’ division which will specialise in on-site steel strengthening and repairs.
