RIN events are due to return to quarterly nationwide with the 2022 calendar featuring:

- -Thursday, May 12 DW Stadium, Wigan.
- -Thursday, September 8 Derby Arena, Derby.
- -Thursday, November 17 York Racecourse.

Keven added: "We are expecting the RIN event in York to be our most successful yet, so I'd recommend that exhibitors act quickly to secure a space.

"All of our events accommodate busy working diaries so people can turn up and leave as and when they want throughout the event.

"For those attending on the day it will prove an invaluable networking opportunity, free of charge, at a time of so much opportunity.

"For everyone attending it will be the chance to make new contacts and reinforce existing relationships, keep up to date with the industry and competitors and network with a wide range of businesses all under one roof."
