TBF is a not-for-profit membership charity embracing everybody in Great Britain engaged in the public transport industry, and its related services.

As a registered charity, the fund is governed by a board of trustees, most of who work in the public



transport industry, and they decide on all benefits awarded.

Patrons include leading figures in the major transport groups and the trades unions.
