

Transport for Wales seek feedback for Holyhead station transformation

Transport for Wales (TfW) is looking to transform Holyhead station into a local transport hub and needs your feedback on its proposals.

Options for improving the station cover a broad range of areas including signage, passenger facilities, active travel, integration between different modes of transport, the look and feel of the station and tackling anti-social behaviour.

The options consultation period began on 10 November and runs until 22 December 2022. You can find out about the proposals and complete an online feedback form by visiting: haveyoursay.tfw.wales/holyhead-station.
